Water Quality Update

The water district plans to start up Well #10 this week to help meet summer water demands. Because district wells draw from the Widefield aquifer, we monitor for Perfluorinated Compounds (PFCs) at all of our well sites.

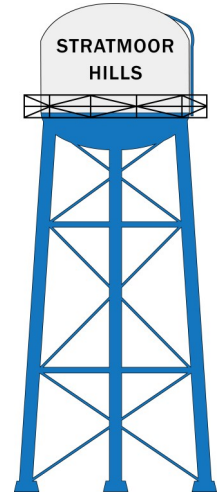


When Well #10 was out of service, raw water samples were taken from the well to determine the PFC concentrations at this location. All results were below the U.S. EPA's Health Advisory Level of 70 parts per trillion (for PFOA and PFOS). As a precautionary measure, we chose to install treatment equipment to ensure that our customers receive safe water.

Last summer, at our Well #4 site, the ion exchange equipment removed PFCs to levels below the detection limits of 2 parts per trillion. We expect the same results at Well #10. The district will continue to monitor the well when it is in operation and will notify customers immediately if PFC levels ever become close to exceeding any health advisory levels.

Perfluorinated compounds are currently unregulated in drinking water but the U.S. EPA is currently considering regulating certain PFCs and is planning to hold a Community Engagement event in the Widefield/Security area during the week of August 6th. The district encourages anyone with questions or concerns about PFCs to attend this event. Once details are available, they will be posted at the district office.
