Lift Station Retention Pond

Staff recently completed the construction of a 100,000 gallon retention basin at our B Plant lift station.

Now that this project is complete, the District will have roughly one day of storage to divert flows to if there were ever any mechanical problem at this facility. This lift station pumps all of the sewer flows from Stratmoor Valley to Colorado Springs where it is eventually treated at their Las Vegas Treatment Plant.



Staff Applying Finishing Touches to Pond

This project was completed internally by District staff over a period of several months. Nearly 1500 cubic yards of dirt was hauled into the facility for the construction of a berm that supports a polyethylene liner. Now that this pond is complete, improvements to the existing B Plant lift station can be made. The Sanitation District plans to start construction on the second phase of this project within a few weeks.


Sewer Lining Project Complete

A contractor was hired to line nearly 500 feet of sewer main at three separate bridge crossings within the District. A state of the art "cured-in-place" styrene lining system was used that will protect the existing steel casing and extend the life of the pipe for another 50 to 100 years.

EPA Community Event

The District participated in a U.S. EPA community engagement event held at Hotel Elegante on August 7th and 8th to make certain they understood the impact (and costs) that Perfluorinated Compounds (PFCs) have had on the Water District and its customers. The District Manager reported that even though our raw (untreated) groundwater PFC levels have been below the health advisory level, the District will continue to provide treatment that removes them further, to ensure that our customers always receive safe drinking water.


If you believe you may be late making your payment, please call us to make arrangements to avoid the \$30.00 delinquent fee.
