Subject: Prohibit Weapons on District Property by the Public

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to set forth rules in accordance with State laws

regarding Weapons on District Property.

Section 1. Per CRS 29-11.7-104 – Regulation regarding carrying of Firearms and posting of signs. A local government may enact an ordinance, regulation or other law that prohibits the open carrying of a firearm in a building or specific area within the local government's jurisdiction. If a local government enacts an ordinance, regulation or other law that prohibits the open carrying of a firearm in a building or specific area, the local government shall post signs at the public entrances to the building or specific area informing persons that the open carrying of firearms is prohibited in the building or specific area.

- Section 2. At no time is anyone allowed to open carry any type of Firearm or bring a weapon onto property of the Fire District. The term "weapon" shall include any type of firearm; explosives; chemical sprays; knives; and any other item that is designed, or which the individual then in possession intends or threatens to use, to inflict serious bodily injury, including death, to themselves or another person. The foregoing prohibition on weapons does not apply to individuals who are authorized to carry a weapon under applicable law, or required to possess such weapon in the performance of duties of the District or a law enforcement agency, except where the individual intends or threatens to use the weapon to inflict serious bodily injury, including death, to themselves or another person outside the performance of their duties.
- **Section 3.** Any individual in violation of this policy will be asked to remove the weapon from the premises and/ or leave the premises. If the individual refuses to remove the weapon or leave the premise then he/she will be escorted from the Fire District property by the appropriate law agency which will be contacted.
